* THE FUNCTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD

- * Planning for the present and future operation of the school.
- * Providing membership on selection panels for the employment of staff to the school in accordance with CECWA policy.
- * Providing membership on the panel which recommends the appointment of a Principal in accordance with CECWA policy.
- * Disseminating information about the school and about Catholic education to persons and organisations in the local Catholic community.
- * Liaising in all matters relating to financial management of the school with persons and organisations in the local Catholic community.
- * Assisting in the managing of all the finances associated with the school.
- * Advising the Principal with respect to School Policy.

* THE CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD

- * Possession of an enthusiasm for and a willingness to promote Catholic schooling.
- * A deep interest in the welfare of all students and staff.
- * A desire to give service to the Catholic School Community
- * An ability to work co-operatively and constructively with all other members of the Board.
- * Sufficiency of time to devote to Board duties.
- * An ability and desire to uphold confidentiality in Board matters.
- * Possession of special skills that will be an asset to the Board.

* THE TERM OF SERVICE

- * Is for two years but any retiring member may be re-elected, provided that they have not served for more than six consecutive years. Maximum number of elected members is six, however up to two extra members may be co-opted if deemed necessary.

* DUTIES

- * Attendance at the monthly meeting, normally held on the third Wednesday evening of the month.
- * Participation in an induction evening, usually held at the Catholic Education Office one evening early in the year (new Board members only).
- * Being prepared to be part of sub committees, as deemed necessary, in the carrying out of School Board business.
